The old wooden building of the department store was connected to the new fire resistant building and sales floors were shared; however, there were no fire shutters or any fire safety equipment in the connecting portion. No fire patrol was carried out at night, which resulted in delay of fire discovery and communications, and led to such a large fire. The fire emerged in an area that was packed by the post-war wooden barrack stores, and the department store was tightly surrounded by hazardous structures.
